- Mark Lowry, a Christian comedian, points out "whether things are good or bad, everything is <u>temporary</u>."
- In John 3:16, John uses the term "world". He is referring to **people**.
- In 1 John 2:15-17, John uses the term "the world" as a catchall for that which <u>distracts</u> us from God.
- <u>Temptation</u> in any form takes your attention from what is <u>holy</u>, <u>good</u>, <u>right</u>, and <u>true</u>.
- John lists three things that he believes steal our attention from God. The first is <u>lust of the flesh</u>.
- Lust is a turning of one's <u>heart</u> towards something.
- Something that steals our attention from God is when our heart turns towards the <u>natural desires</u> we possess that are <u>opposed</u> to God.
- The second thing John believes steals our attention from God is: <u>lust of the eyes</u>.
- Eve **saw**, **appreciated**, **and wanted** that which she shouldn't have.
- There is a <u>connection</u> between what we see to our <u>hearts</u> and our <u>soul</u> that we often fail to acknowledge.
- The third thing John believes steals our attention from God is the **pride** of life.
- The pride of life is described as one who <u>boasts</u> of what he <u>has</u> and <u>does</u>.
- Jesus tells us to love **<u>people</u>**. **Invest** in God's Kingdom.
