- You can't base your faith on mere <u>feelings</u>. They are <u>momentary</u> responses to stimuli.
- To share this life with God... or to be <u>born</u> <u>of</u> <u>God</u> is to believe that Jesus is who He says He is.
- Believing that Jesus is who He says He is, is the <u>key</u> to salvation.
- In 1 John 5:3, John says you love God by obeying God's commands.
- When you give your life over to Jesus, you love others <u>sacrificially</u> because you've given up your own <u>selfish</u> nature.
- If following Jesus is difficult for you, it's because you've got <u>competing</u> interests.
- The world's <u>desires</u> compete with God's <u>commands</u>.
- When you give yourself fully over to His commands, you <u>overcome</u> the world through faith.
- John lists three examples of imagery to offer proof of Jesus to prove our faith is not in vain:
 - Water, referring to Jesus' baptism.
 - <u>Blood</u>, referring to Jesus' death.
 - Spirit, which leads us to know that Jesus is real.
- You know you're a part of God's family when you find yourself living a different kind of life that's pointed <u>outward</u> instead of inward.
