- In 2 John, John address the letter to "the lady chosen by God and to her children." Most scholars think the "lady" is the <u>church</u> and the children are the <u>members</u> of the church.
- You have the ability to <u>affect</u> someone around you. You have the ability to <u>model</u> love.
- The church should be a place of <u>hospitality</u> and <u>grace</u> to both sinners and saints.
- John cautions us to be careful who you <u>listen</u> to. Not everyone has the same belief in Jesus.
- Just because the name of Jesus is <u>attached</u> to something, it does not mean that Jesus is <u>in</u> something.
- 3 John 1:4 says, "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth."
- Life is a series of highs and lows. But to look back and see that it actually made a <u>difference</u> is a crown of righteousness we should all strive for.
- In 3 John 1:11, John encourages us not to imitate what is <u>evil</u> but what is <u>good</u>.
- We tend to <u>judge</u> people based off a <u>moment</u> in their stories...but until the day they die, people's stories aren't over.
- John taught us what it looks like to embody the <u>heart</u> of Christ which is filled with holiness, rightness, goodness, and truth all expressed through love.
